"Music Tiggers is the only social interaction my son has (apart from going to his special school). He enjoys Tiggers and I don't have to worry about explaining his autism. Tiggers is a lifeline to us both and in my opinion (as a very stressed mum) desperately needs more continuous funding."

"Improved his interaction skills with other children. He really enjoys it and has shown a big interest in music. He has also learned how to take turns. It is great for him to be part of a group and not be different."
